

CHAPTER 4

BOARD MEMBER COMPENSATION PER DISTRICT MEETING FOR THE LAS GALLINAS VALLEY SANITARY DISTRICT

ARTICLE I. HISTORY. On July 5, 2000, Governor Gray Davis signed into law Senate Bill 1559. This law addresses the Board of Director stipend threshold for Board Member compensation for attendance at Board representation meetings. Previously, the compensation was capped at One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per meeting. The new law changes the stipend threshold from the current level of a maximum One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per Board representation meeting to a proposed minimum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). Furthermore, the law authorizes the District Board of Directors to increase the Board Members stipend by five (5) percent annually from 1986 to date and in succeeding years.

ARTICLE II. PROPOSAL. The Board representation meeting stipend for Board Members shall be increased from the current One Hundred Dollar (\$100.00) level to the maximum allowable under Senate Bill 1559 effective January 1, 2001. Furthermore, the aforementioned new meeting stipend should be increased annually, the maximum allowable under Senate Bill 1559 effective on January 1, 2002 and on the first day of January in each succeeding year thereafter.

ARTICLE III. As of January 1, 2008, the per meeting payment for Board Members was \$252.70. Any further increases as permitted by the Health and Safety Code and the Water Code shall be by a duly passed ordinance.
