<sup>1</sup>Private – Applies to plumbing fixtures in residences and apartments, to private bathrooms in hotels and hospitals, and to restrooms in commercial establishments where fixtures are intended for the use of a family or an individual.

<sup>2</sup>Public – Applies to plumbing fixtures that are not defined as private or private use.
