Hi Mark,

Laura Lovett, Pres of CA Native Plant Marin, came to GWC meeting last night but her request was directed at LGVSD. A nursery is going out of business and they can be the recipients of 200-300 plants, from 4 inch pots to 25 gal pots. They are planning to put in a native garden at WildCare, as soon as they know where (and they are waiting on our pipeline project to be finalized and done so we aren't ripping up their area--or they aren't planting where we will be working).

So they need a temporary holding area, with water, for over the summer until they can get the plants to various homes, schools, restoration sites, etc. Laura knew about the Project Seed area and was wondering if that was still available and if they could store the plants there and come by and water as needed. Shade and protection from deer? might be useful, if it's there. And if we needed or could use any of the plants, I'm sure we could ask.

I haven't looked at the area behind the lab to know if it's suitable, and this is probably a matter for the board to decide, but do you see any problems with this? Or is there stuff there that would make this impractical?
